Updates Regarding the COVID-19 Restrictions

January 26, 2021

The Israeli government has approved the closure of Ben-Gurion International Airport (Israel's main port of entry) from tonight, Tuesday (26 January), at midnight until the end of the current lockdown (Sunday, 31 January).

The plan approved by the Israeli government includes the full closure of the airport until the lockdown ends, with the exception of flights for humanitarian purposes and extraordinary circumstances.

Consequently, the entry of experts to the State of Israel will be prohibited until Sunday at midnight.

Both the current lockdown in Israel, and the closure of the airport, may be extended by the government.
