Proclamation Suspending Entry of Foreign Workers to the US

June 24, 2020

The White House announced on June 22, 2020, a new Proclamation Suspending Entry of Aliens Who Present a Risk to the U.S. Labor Market Following the Coronavirus Outbreak.

Here are some of the key terms:

Due to the extraordinary economic disruptions caused by the COVID-19 outbreak, the entry into the United States of aliens seeking entry pursuant to any of the following nonimmigrant visas has been suspended, subject to certain exceptions:

- (a) an H-1B or H-2B visa, and any alien accompanying or following to join such alien;
- (b) a J visa, to the extent the alien is participating in an intern, trainee, teacher, camp counselor, au pair, or summer work travel program, and any alien accompanying or following to join such alien; and
- (c) an L visa, and any alien accompanying or following to join such alien.

The proclamation will be in effect until December 31, 2020, and may be extended.

The proclamation will generally take effect at 12:01 a.m. EDT on June 24, 2020.
