The Entry Of Foreign Nationals Into Israel During Covid-19

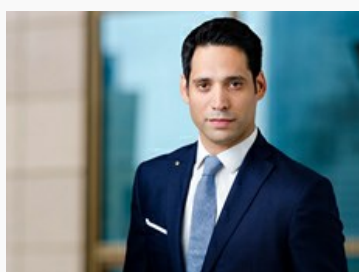
The Israeli government has announced on media channels that due to increase in COVID-19 cases related to the Delta Variant, it is **withdrawing** its previous announcement of June 20th regarding the planned relaxation of orders related to the entry policy for foreign nationals into the State of Israel, which had been scheduled to take effect on July 1, 2021.

Under the Ministry of Interior's previous announcement, which has now been withdrawn, foreign nationals who are vaccinated were supposed be able to enter Israel without the need for a prior approval.

Nonetheless, please note that this new announcement does not affect the existing policy regarding Business Visitor Visas ("BV"), which may be approved by the Israeli regulator prior to travel, or the possibility of applying for Work Permits and Work Visas.
