New Regulation for Entering Israel and Quarantine (Green/Red Countries)

August 17, 2020

Flight from Green countries

Israeli citizens/residents or foreign nationals with a Special Entry Permit (“SEP”) departing from “green countries” will not have to enter quarantine on entering the State of Israel.

(Please note that those who visited in “red countries” during the 14 days before the date of the flight to Israel from a green country, will need to be in quarantine when they enter the State of Israel).

Flight from Red countries

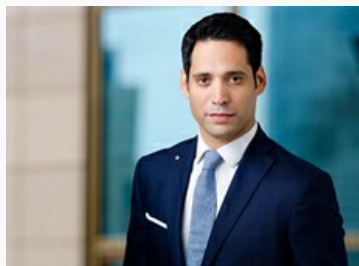
Israeli citizens/residents or foreign nationals with a Special Entry Permit (“SEP”) that are flying from, or were in, “red countries” during the 14 days prior to the date of their flight to Israel, will need to be in quarantine in accordance with the Ministry of Health regulations, and fill out a form to give details regarding their quarantine.

Continued flights (connection)

Those flying to the State of Israel from a “green country” and making a connecting flight (connection) in a “red country” will be exempt from quarantine, as long as they do not leave the airport.
